

SWIMMER DROP-OFF & PICK-UP POLICY

The safety of all swimmers is the highest priority for First Colony Swim Team ("FCST"). To ensure this, FCST will not leave a swimmer alone at a practice facility without a staff member present. In order to assist with this:

- Swimmers must not be dropped off more than 15 minutes before their practice is scheduled to start*; and,
- Swimmers must be picked up no later than 15 minutes after their practice is scheduled to end.
 - FCST reserves the right to impose a fine for late pick-ups. A late pick-up is any pick-up which occurs after the 15 minute grace period. This fine will be assessed based on scheduled practice times and by family (i.e., one late pick up for your first swimmer and one late pick up for your second swimmer counts as two offenses).
 - Fines are as follows:

1st Offense - Warning

2nd Offense - \$1/minute

3rd Offense - \$5/minute

All additional Offenses - \$10/minute

*When dropping off your swimmer, please ensure a coach is present on deck before leaving.
